The free programme should be well balanced and consist of varied elements such as jumps, spins, steps and other linking movements executed with ease and fluency, and in harmony with the selected music.

Vocal music with words is not allowed.

All the elements should be connected by different linking steps and by other skating movements using the entire rink surface. Forward and backward crossovers are not considered as linking steps.

Music must be recorded on CD.

There will be two separate rankings for male and female entrants in each category.

Important note: In compulsory and free dances, the judges will pay particular attention to the skating quality, the speed and the precision of the steps.

N.B.: Candidates may compete both in couples and solo. They should specify on the entrance form.
